MEMBERSHIP TYPES AND FEES

SENIOR MEMBERSHIP

- Senior Members may register any number of animals in the Holstein Friesian NZ Herd Book.
- Senior Members have voting rights for election of Ward Directors and are eligible to hold any office in the Association.

Annual Subscription fee: \$300.00 (GST incl.)

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

- Associate Members may own no more than 20 registered Holstein Friesian dairy cattle, including cows, bulls, and young stock.
- Associate Members shall receive services on a fees-per-request basis.
- Associate Members cannot vote for election of Board Members and are not eligible to hold office on the Board. However, they are otherwise entitled to all other rights and privileges.

Annual subscription fee: \$86.00 (GST incl.)

JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

- Junior Members must be under the age of 21 years.
- Junior Members do not have voting powers and are not eligible to hold office in the Association.
- At the end of the financial year in which they reach the age of 21 years, Junior Members must change to either Senior or Associate Members.

NOTE: All membership applications must be accompanied by the appropriate membership fee at the time of application.

STUD NAME REGISTRATION

- Before registering any animals, it is necessary for members to forward a stud name (also known as 'stud/herd prefix' with which to prefix the names of your pedigree animals).
- Choose a short stud name. The rules state that full animal names may be no more than 25 characters including the registration suffix requirement, so those breeders who have chosen long stud names strike quite a few problems. Imagine a stud naming a registry-recovered ET, who also happens to be a red factor twin – 'STUD NAME-ET-TW-RED-RR'. This leaves little space at all for a name.
- There needs to be room for additional information such as the 'S1F' suffix (Supplementary Register Animals), 'ET' suffix (embryo transplants), 'OC' (off-colour animals), and 'RED' (Red animals).
- The stud name, once approved, is reserved for the sole use of your membership and therefore cannot be duplicated for another member.
- Please provide a possible three stud names in order of preference in case someone has already registered your first choice.
